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D1: Dakar

*Arrival in Dakar at LSS airport with flight N°.....Assistance by an local representative through customs & policies then transfer to your down town (4 stars) hotel
Accommodation on BB*

D2: Dakar/Goree Island

*Breakfast at your hotel
In the morning you will visit Dakar . The Senegal capital will show you its various contrasts, both modern and ancient. You will stop at the president's palace and admire its red spahi guards, stop at the House of Parliament and the Cathedral, the Mosque, the Millennium door. Visit of the picturesque district of Medina so lively. Visit the university and Fann residential district featuring the new Senegalese architecture style, visit the Monument of the African Renaissance, visit various markets including the healers market of Tilene.*

At noon transfer to Goree Island and have lunch before visiting the island classified monument of the world cultural patrimony. Visit the House of Slave, visit the historic museum, the fort and the Goree memorial. Return to Dakar at 5:00pm. In the evening, dinner in a typical restaurant of Dakar where you will enjoy Senegalese food, genuine and spicy. Overnight at your hotel. BB accommodation at (4 stars) hotel



D3: Dakar/Pink Lake /St -Louis

Breakfast at hotel, then departure in A/C vehicle to St Louis with a visit stop at the Pink Lake

Take a four wheel drive tour on the sand dunes surrounding the salty lake. Visit Fulani nomadic villages and interact with local inhabitants harvesting the salt.

After lunch at local restaurant facing the lake, proceed further north to St Louis , via Thies, Kebemer, Louga

HB accommodation at (3 stars) sea side hotel



D4: St Louis/Djoudj National Bird Park

Departure after breakfast , after one hour drive, arrive at Djoudj World birds Park N° 3, then embark on boat ride through the various meanders of the Senegal river.

Possibility to watch over 350 different migrant birds coming all the way down from different parts of the world.

It will be also possible to observe other different kind of wildlife , such as: crocodile, hyenas, warthogs, monkeys, pythons etc

PM take a St Louis (former Senegal capital city), horse drawn carriage sightseeing tour. Also visit Guet Ndar the picturesque fishing quarter.

HB accommodation at (3 stars) hotel



D5: St Louis/Kaolack/Toubacouta

Early morning departure to Toubacouta Mandingo village, located down by the Saloum river famous birds sanctuary.

After your lunch stop in Kaolack, visit the Senegal hugest market rich of medicinal herbs, colourful cotton fabrics, encens, etc...HB accommodation will be at (3 stars) lodge



D6: Saloum River Boat Ride

Breakfast at lodge , then start your full day boat ride through the Saloum river delta inhabitants by various plants, birds, shell, monkies etc...

Visit fishing villages & interact with local chiefs. Pic nic lunch and relax at white sandy beach before driving back to Toubacouta Dinner with entertainment and overnight at (3 stars) lodge



D7: Toubacouta/Banjul (The Gambia)

After breakfast proceed further south through Niombato (Mandingo area) to Karang (formalities stop at the Senegambian border) and drive to Barra where you will cross the ferry and arrive in Banjul to participate at the 10th edition of the International Roots Festival 4th -8th February 2011
